The NEED Grants for Academic Programs (NGAP) funding is continuing. Under the NGAP heading, the ANS NEED Committee is continuing to make funds available to a limited number of nuclear programs for recruitment activities for women and minorities. This recruitment must be toward enrollment in some nuclear-related area of interest to one of the ANS Professional Divisions and must be specifically directed to the NEED aspect of recruitment versus general recruiting.

This report is important for the Committee since we always need to be able to justify our activities to the larger membership of the Society. It would be especially useful if you could supply photographs of appropriate use of the program funds. If these were suitable for advertisement, we could be even more effective in justifying this activity to the ANS membership.
