

Waste Isolation Pilot Plant—the Nation's Nuclear Repository

AECOM-led teams have been an integral part of solving the nation's nuclear waste problem at the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP)



WIPP is the nation's only licensed deep-geologic nuclear waste repository for permanent disposal of DOE's Cold War legacy transuranic (TRU) waste. WIPP resumed its important national cleanup mission in January. Over the next 33 years, WIPP is expected to receive approximately 37,000 shipments of TRU waste. In addition to operating the repository, AECOM also coordinates the DOE's National Transuranic Waste Program to assure that all waste meets federal and state packaging, transportation, and disposal requirements.
