EMBEDDED TOPICAL CONFERENCES (Class III)

Embedded Conferences do not have a budget; instead, they are folded into the National Conference.

Embedded topical conferences are technical topical conferences sponsored by one or multiple technical divisions of ANS held concurrently and co-located with ANS national conferences. The ANS division(s) involved is solely responsible for the technical content for the embedded topical conference including the call for papers, paper review and organization of technical sessions. The program for the embedded topical conference will be included in the national conference program. The presentation summaries will be published separately. Any additional cost will be the responsibility of the sponsoring division.

Divisions that hold an embedded topical conference at an ANS national conference shall be compensated for their efforts. Each milestone must be met by the deadline established. A schedule for the development of the topical conference program will be established by ANS to meet publication and conference requirements for the national conference.

The following incentive will be applied for each milestone achieved by the established deadline:

- \$500 Developing the call for papers
- \$500 Completing the initial technical review
- \$500 Resolving all paper reviews
- \$500 Finalizing the official program and publication
- \$1,000 If all four milestones are completed by the established deadlines

Bonus structure:

- For conferences with full papers, the total payout shall be multiplied by 1.5
- For conferences with 90-160 submittals, the total payout shall be multiplied by 1.5 (medium-sized embedded)
- For conferences with >160 submittals, the total payout shall be multiplied by 1.8 (large-sized embedded)
- If multiple divisions are involved, the divisions will determine how the compensation will be shared.

Step 2:

- Present the request to embed at the next NPC screening meeting.
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Step 3:

- Complete the technical conference publication plan and send to the ANS program specialist. The program specialist will add the publication plan to the next conference publication transactions committee (CPTC) agenda. Final deadlines will need to match ANS deadlines.
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Step 4:

- Contact the ANS program specialist to begin the process for call for papers.
- Start monthly committee calls and include ANS staff.
