## Steps to Starting Local Section

as of December 2013

1. Convene at least one meeting with nuclear professionals from your geographic area interested in forming a local section.
2. Complete the Local Section petition form which should include at least twenty (20) signatures from ANS members. (Not all signatures need to be from members from the geographic area of the proposed local section.)
3. Include with your petition a brief description of your plans for local section activities. This will help the Local Section Committee in the review process.
  - a. Planned meetings
  - b. Leaders' commitment to starting the section (brief paragraph)
  - c. List of any local corporations, government agencies, or other organizations willing to be supportive of the section.
  - d. Preliminary plan for sending information on the sections' activities to professionals in the nuclear field that live in the area
  - e. Benefits the section will provide for its member
  - f. Plans to recruit and train future leaders
4. Submit the completed Petition form to Aubrey Whittington [awhittington@ans.org](mailto:awhittington@ans.org) at the ANS headquarters. She will forward the petition on to the Local Section Committee for their review.
5. The Local Sections Committee will review and if approved, will recommend to the board of directors that the proposed local section be given its charter.
6. Once board of directors approves the section, the Local Section Committee will assign a committee member as a liaison for support and send the new section or branch the ANS Member mailing list in their area. Staff liaison and local section chair will give more information to section upon approval.
7. Develop rules to go with the standard by-laws.
