Responsible for the first SAR of a large research reactor (100 MWt) that followed RG 1.70

Responsible for first PRA of a large research reactor and used it to risk-inform upgrades

Lecturer on reactor safety at many universities including the University of Tennessee, NC State, Georgia Tech and several other universities on research and test facilities, advanced reactors, and space reactors

IAEA Instructor for inspectors of test reactors
