About the UWC

The UWC is an annual meeting of the minds that consistently generates well-supported, practical recommendations designed to address the industry's most pressing needs. The theme of the UWC is "Innovating for a Sustainable Nuclear Future". There will be eleven Technical Tracks over three days offering the latest information in thought-provoking break-out sessions, to tackle the challenges of sustainability. The conference provides an excellent opportunity for benchmarking and sharing best practices. The event includes a vendor technology expo with over 90 companies exhibiting. The Goal of the UWC

An important part of the UWC is knowledge sharing. The goal of the conference is to develop actionable recommendations that professionals at nuclear power plants can put into practice. These recommendations come from presentations and discussions at dozens of breakout sessions. The Technical Program Chair distributes the recommendations to the functional area managers across the U.S. Fleet at the conclusion of the conference.
