U.S. Energy Information Administration says nuclear electricity generation capacity in Middle East could reach 14 GWe by 2028. IAEA to expand cooperation on SMR development. 
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# Waste Management

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Agreement signed in proposed sale of Vermont Yankee from Entergy to NorthStar Group Services. License exemption will expedite transfer of spent fuel to dry storage at Vermont Yankee. NRC dockets Holtec's license application for a consolidated interim storage facility for spent fuel. Government Accountability Office sustains protest of contract for processing liquid waste at Savannah River Site. Plutonium-44 to be recovered from Mark-18A targets stored at SRS. NRC's management of decommissioning financial assurance instruments found lacking. U.K. Nuclear Decommissioning Authority found to have mismanaged Magnox decommissioning contract.

# Fuel

Energy Fuels receives approval to expand La Sal Complex in Utah; other mining developments. Anfield Energy to acquire Charlie project in Wyoming; other business developments. U.S. production of U<sub>3</sub>O<sub>8</sub> in 2017 lowest since 2004. NRC hosts public meeting to address status of accident-tolerant fuel development.
