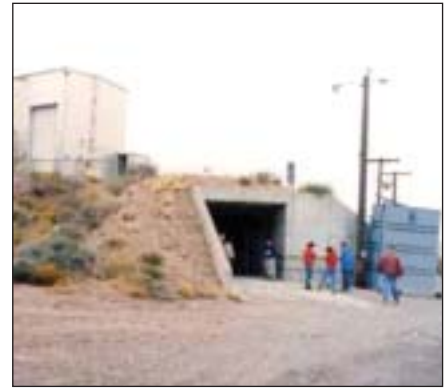


Radwaste Solutions
